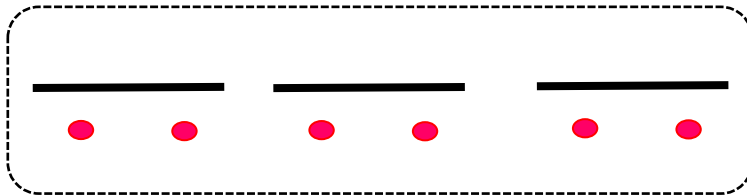


## Multiplying a one-digit number by a two-digit number
